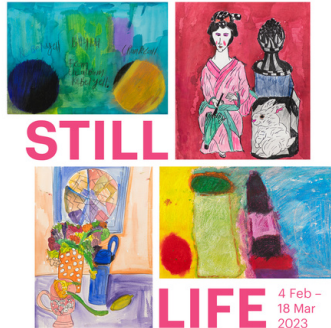

The exhibition opens on Saturday 4 February 2023, 3pm at Arts Project Australia gallery.

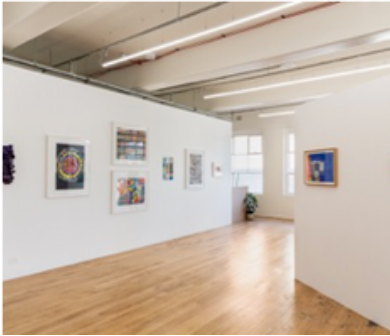


Arts Project Australia's gallery is located on Level 1 in the Perry Street building at Collingwood Yards.

*Looking Glass*, a 2-hour digital still life drawing workshop will be run by Alice Oehr on Saturday 25 February from 1:30PM.

# Featured artists



Anthony Romagnano is an Arts Project Australia artist creating artwork in pencil, paint and digital media.

Anthony uses popular culture and still life images as inspiration for his work. Anthony's artworks begin with an outline which he then fills with blocks of vivid colour.
