The gallery staff also find other well known studios for the artists to visit and make art in.




They also find other opportunities for the artists, like being in art prizes.



The gallery is open from Wednesday to Friday from 11am to 5pm. On Saturdays it is open from 12pm to 4pm.



The gallery is closed on public holidays.



Please contact us if you want to check that the gallery is open before you visit.



The gallery is wheelchair accessible via a lift. You can use the lift to go to level 1 where the gallery is located



All exhibition openings at the gallery are Auslan interpreted.



Service animals are welcome in the gallery.



The gallery is usually a quiet place, but openings can be noisy. We recommend people with hearing sensitivities bring hearing protection for when it is noisy.



A quiet room is available during openings. The gallery staff will direct you to where it is on the day if you need to use it.



The gallery has two sets of noise cancelling headphones for visitors to borrow while in the space. There are fully accessible toilets for all genders located on the same level as the gallery.



There is one wheelchair accessible carpark on site. It can be found via the Johnson Street carpark entrance.



There is on street parking available in the streets near Collingwood Yards.
