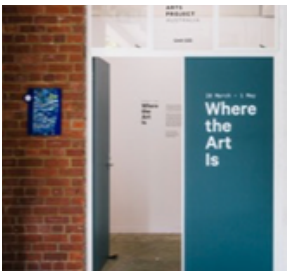
Exhibition information

- Katherine makes paintings and drawings.



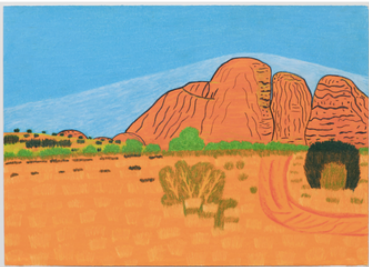
- Katherine is inspired by landscapes and animals.

- Robyn is inspired by the shapes, colours and patterns in nature.



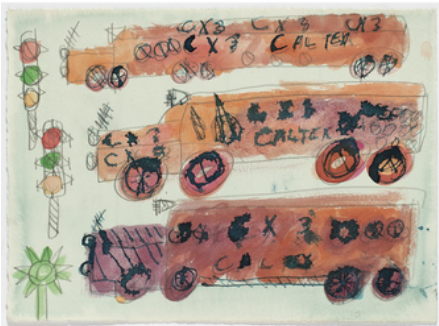
- The images on the left are some of Robyn's works in the show.
