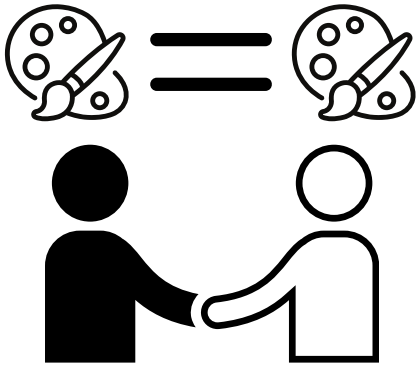
**Arts Project Australia supports neurodivergent artists and artists with intellectual disabilities.**

The artists who come to the studio work hard.



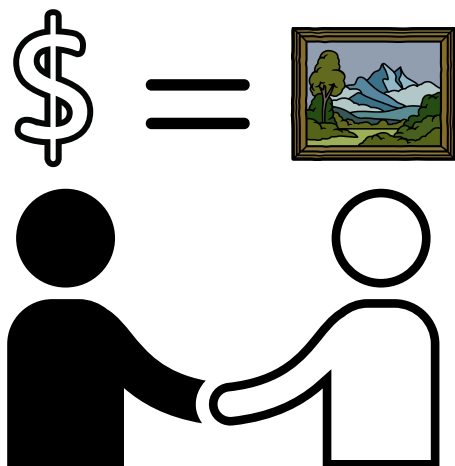
They also have a lot of fun.

The artists get paid for the artwork they sell, the same way non-disabled artists do.



The artists in the studio make whatever they want.



They can paint, draw, sculpt and print.



They can also make digital art, photos and zines.



The studio staff are all artists who have studied art.



This means they know a lot about art.



They share what they know about art with the artists. The staff do not teach art. Instead, they give advice that helps artists work out what they want to make.



**We also have a gallery.**



**It is located at Collingwood Yards, 35 Johnson Street, Collingwood Victoria.**



**It is on Level one of the Perry Street building in Collingwood Yards.**



**The gallery is where artists who make work in our studio display their art.**





Many people visit the gallery to see the art.



Some people who visit the gallery buy the art on display.



The gallery staff work hard to inform people about the art the artists make.



The gallery staff also find other galleries the artists can show their art in.



The gallery staff also find other well known studios for the artists to visit and make art in.



They also find other opportunities for the artists, like being in art prizes.



We have an in-person art program at our studio you can join.



This means you work in the studio with other people.



We are a registered National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) organisation.

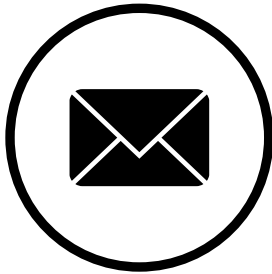


This means if you get money from the NDIS you can use it to pay to attend our art programs.
