



 Arts Project Australia's gallery is in Collingwood yards. It is located on Level 1 of the Perry Street building.


Exhibition information

• It has drawing, paintings and sculptures on display.






 The other artists in this show are David Fitzpatrick, Lychandra Gieseman, Michael Candy and Pascale Giorgi.

- The images on the left are some of Christian's paintings in the show.


Martin Forster

- The image on the left are some of Samraing's drawings in the show.


External Artists
