
Exhibition information

- Daniel makes drawings, paintings, ceramics and zines.


- Daniel's artworks are inspired by his favourite fairytales.


Jasmin Kolodziejczyk

- She is also inspired by what people do.




- Margaret also works in the Gallery Team at Arts Project Australia.
