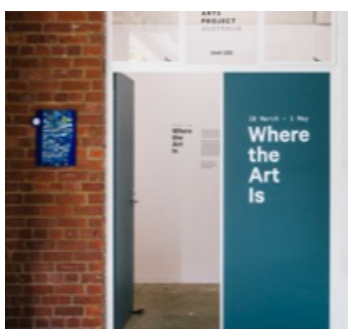
Exhibition information

- The images on the left are of some of the works that are in the show.

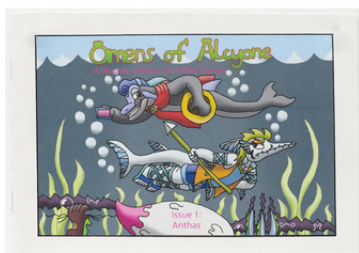

- There are also works by Molica Silk, Salome Felsinger, and Spenser Coombe.



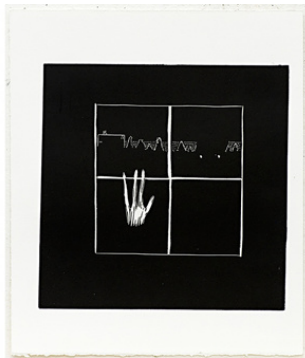
- The show is curated by Spenser Coombe and the Arts Project Australia Gallery staff.

- The images on the left are some of Andrew's works in the show.
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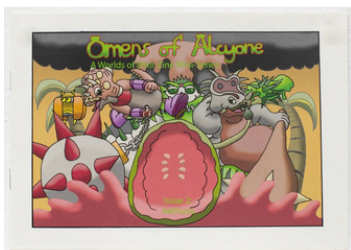

- David makes drawings, paintings and ceramics.

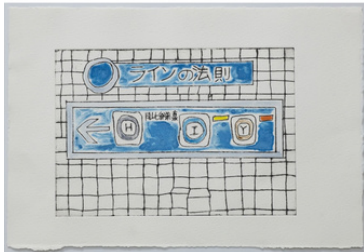


- David is inspired by science, technology, geology, philosophy and patterns.

Jimmy Tran



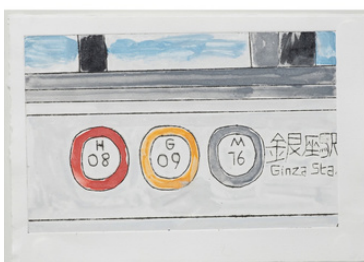
- Jimmy Tran was born in Melbourne in 1997.
