Arts Project Australia offers creative and accessible studio programs for artists living with an intellectual disability. Flagship platform **Satellite Arts** supports artists who benefit from online infrastructure and remote access to the supportive studio.



About Satellite Arts

Satellite Arts supports participants in developing their art practice by offering the opportunity to join an online creative community. The program gives artists access to professional mentorship and assistance from a highly qualified team of staff artists and the chance to create, discuss, and explore art in a supportive group environment. The content is tailored to each artist's personal working preferences, with the option to join both individual and group sessions on Zoom.

Satellite Arts follows Victorian school term schedule with holiday breaks:

- TERM 2: Monday 19 April – Saturday 26 June
- TERM 3: Monday 12 July – Saturday 18 September
- TERM 4: Monday 4 October – Thursday 16 December

Studio Code of Conduct



It is everyone's responsibility to work together to make Satellite Arts a supportive and positive environment. Satellite Arts artists are required to:

- help one another to ensure Satellite Arts is a safe and productive environment.
- participate in the program from a quiet location, free from distractions.
- treat all other members of the group and staff with respect at all times.
- tell staff if you feel upset, angry, or frustrated, and they will try to help.
- maintain an atmosphere free from bullying, intimidation, violence and sexual harassment.
- participate in group discussions professionally and respectfully.
- allow each member of the group equal opportunity to contribute during the session.


Participation Guidelines

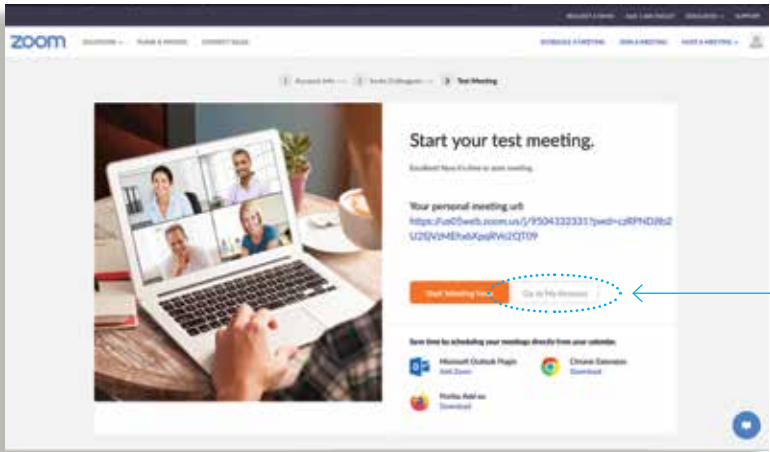
Fill in the form by typing in your name and choosing a password. Retype the password in the confirm password section and click **Continue**.

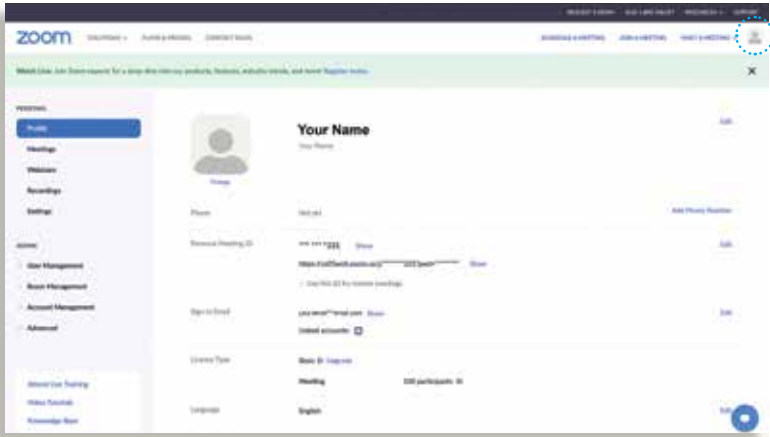
We don't need to invite colleagues. Click the **I'm not a robot** text box and then click the **Skip this step** button.
